

That's why we created «Club 152», to help finance the construction of the future Porrentruy Museum, opening in 2018, as part of the major international JURASSICA project. Along with the Collection Management Centre and representatives from the University Department of Geosciences, which will both be established at the same time, the project will enable us to locate, manage and preserve exceptional discoveries.

By supporting this project, you will be part of an exciting adventure. Club 152, as its name suggests, will exclusively bring together the 152 members, representing one of the key periods of the remarkable history told by JURASSICA. Your symbolic acquisition, for a donation of between 1,000 and 10,000 francs (or a sum of your choice), will represent a million years of this history and entitle you to a wealth of benefits.

Why this approach? The Porrentruy region and its surroundings are home to a natural treasure, unlike any other. The discovery of dinosaur remains in 2002 made headlines across the world. The excavation works carried out as part of the roadworks on the A16 motorway alone unearthed almost a million relics. Among these were countless palaeontological specimens (molluscs, fish, turtles, crocodiles, mammals and plants), with traces of dinosaurs, mammoth tusks and the skeletal remains of other species such as the woolly rhinoceros and the steppe bison, and even remnants of objects made by humans, reflecting the colourful history of our Earth.

JURASSICA aims to provide the vital backdrop to allow us to fully appreciate these discoveries. Establishing the Porrentruy Museum and the Collection Management Centre, and working with representatives within from the University Department of Geosciences, will do justice to this objective by fulfilling three principle aims: to impart knowledge, to undertake scientific research and education, and to manage and preserve our heritage. The future museum will be able to host leading scientific experts to come and hold conferences, as well as budding scientists to enable them to carry out work for their studies. Archaeological digs will be undertaken by the appropriate bodies, and public the will also have access to this piece of world heritage, of course, by visiting interactive museums and field testing as part of an ecotourism approach. After all, everything will have a firm focus on sustainability.

At the moment, JURASSICA already offers additional activities such as the educational «Follow the Giants' Footsteps» trail in Courtedoux, the Botanical Garden and Dinotec in Porrentruy, and even an archaeology site open to the public in the peaks of Porrentruy.

By becoming a member of Club 152, you will be contributing to this exceptional project and leaving your mark on the Swiss cultural landscape.
